

Craft your perfect national park competition

Natural Resources Adelaide Mount Lofty Ranges

Terms and conditions

1. The promoter is: Natural Resources Adelaide Mount Lofty Ranges (“NR AMLR”) whose registered office is the 205 Greenhill Road, Eastwood SA 5063.
2. Employees of NR AMLR, their immediate family members or anyone else connected in any way with the competition or helping to set up the competition are permitted to enter the competition, but are ineligible for the prize.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.

5. Entry is by post only and must be postmarked no later than Friday, 12 June 2015. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
6. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
7. The rules of the competition and the prize for the winner are as follows:
 - Entrants must be primary school students in the metropolitan and Adelaide Hills region, as listed on the Department of Education and Child Development website <http://www.decd.sa.gov.au/locs/>.
 - The challenge is to use Minecraft to create your perfect national park, with trails and other facilities.
 - Entries will take the form of five screenshots and a narrated flythrough of your world of no longer than three minutes. To keep it fair and creative, entrants must use the standard installation of Minecraft without mods, plugins or texture packs. Creative mode is OK.
 - Entries are for class groups from grades four, five, six or seven.
 - Entries will be judged on merit with the following considerations:
 - Usability – the park features need to be able to made in the real world.
 - Sustainability – the park features must complement the environment and use sustainable materials and resources.
 - Design.
 - The fun factor – the park needs features that people will want to use.
 - Year level.
 - How amazing we think it is!
 - Short-listed video entries will be uploaded by NR AMLR to its YouTube channel and embedded on its website/s at the discretion of the judges (and any other site as determined by NR AMLR).
 - Qualifying screenshots will be embedded on the NR AMLR website/s.
 - Competition organisers reserve the right to republish the videos and images in other formats and use them for promotional purposes.
 - Each Minecraft construction must be an original work and must not have been previously published. It must also not have been accepted for publication or under offer to any publisher or entered in another contest until the results of this competition are announced.

- Entries must be submitted to AMLR via post, on a disk or flash drive (these will not be returned), in any of the following formats:
 - AVI
 - QuickTime
 - MPEG4
 - WMV
 - Do not upload your video to YouTube – NR AMLR will do that if it is shortlisted.
 - Images can be in any popular format (e.g. .jpg, .bmp, .png)
 - Submissions will not be returned, so authors should retain a copy.
 - Please do not send your entries via email. They will not be accepted.
 - Please supply us with an email address if you want to be notified that we have received your entry.
 - Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form listing the project title, along with the name, address and contact details of the responsible adult and a list of the participants. Entries submitted without a signed and valid entry form will not be considered.
 - Please include relevant credits on your video.
 - NR AMLR reserves the right to use the videos and images for promotional purposes after the competition is completed.
 - All responsibility for copyright clearance, parent/guardian permissions and content suitability lies with the school or responsible adult.
 - Do not use music, images or any other content for which you do not have copyright ownership or written permission from the copyright owner to use.
 - The winning class will receive an excursion to Belair National Park, including
 - A bus to collect the students (based on a class of 30), their supervising teachers and parents from their school and return them to the school at the end of the day.
 - Free park entry and tennis court hire.
 - Guided walks and rides with a ranger.
 - Environment-based educational activities.
 - The makings of a barbecue lunch (to be cooked by teacher or parents).
8. NR AMRL reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by NR AMLR.
 9. NR AMLR is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
 10. No cash alternative to the prize will be offered. The prize is not transferable.
 11. The winner will be chosen by an independent panel of judges appointed by NR AMLR. The judges reserve the right not to award a prize if, in the judges' opinion, entries are not of a high enough standard.
 12. The winner will be announced on the NR AMLR website <http://www.naturalresources.sa.gov.au/adelaidemtloftyranges> on Monday, 13 July 2015. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 14 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.
 13. The prize must be taken before 31 December 2015. The winning school must give NR AMLR six weeks' notice of the date they intend to take the prize.

14. NR AMLR's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
16. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by Australian law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Australia.

If there is a genuine privacy issue with publicising an entrant's identity this must be disclosed on the entry form.
