<p><b>Men's Fishing</b></p> 	<p>Yalata is renowned for its fishing. On this trip your Anangu guides will take you to some of the fishing holes only known to the locals ... if they are willing to give their secrets away. Men Only. Max 8 seats. Packed lunch provided just in case the fish aren't biting.</p>	<p>\$77</p>
<p><b>Women's Fishing</b></p> 	<p>The Yalata women will head to where the fish are at Mexican Hat, Scott Beach or Fowlers Bay, all popular fishing spots for the Yalata community. We can't guarantee you'll catch a fish but bring your camera just in case. Women Only. Max 8 seats. Packed lunch provided.</p>	<p>\$77</p>
<p><b>Yalata Beach (TBC)</b></p> 	<p>Yalata Beach is usually off limits to everyone other than the Yalata community and other Aboriginal groups on the Far West Coast. The Yalata Beach Road runs straight from the Eyre Hwy for over 20 km to the dunes that protect the coast. (Tour details to be confirmed)</p>	<p>\$77</p>
<p><b>Ooldea Maralinga</b></p> 	<p>The current generations of the community are descendants of Anangu who came to Yalata as a result of the closing of Ooldea Mission when dispossessed of the Maralinga lands. The Yalata Land Management Rangers will take you on a journey back to see what sits on the 'munda' today. Max 8 seats. Packed lunch provided.</p>	<p>\$77</p>
